This session will concentrate on Positive Change: Communicating and Leading Change and will inform, challenge and enable delegates in their role of assisting customers to engage and lead change.

At a time of change in so many housing organisations, supporting those involved and affected by change is an increasingly vital role. Delegates working in groups will take ownership of different parts of the Change Process and explore:

- Types and drivers of change
- Why some resist change
- Leadership qualities
- Emotions and reactions

- Action planning
